**LEGAL PROFESSION AMENDMENT ACT 1996 No 95—  
PROCLAMATION**

(L.S.) G. SAMUELS, Governor.

I, the Honourable Gordon Samuels, AC, Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 2 of the *Legal Profession Amendment Act 1996*, do, by this my Proclamation, appoint 1 April 1997 as the day on which that Act commences, except the following provisions:

- (a) Schedule 4 [6], and
- (b) Schedule 5 [1], [2], [12], [13], [15]–[17], [20], [21] and [23]–[27].

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**
