Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to prescribe the penalty to be imposed by penalty notices issued under section 18B of the *Traffic Act 1909* in respect of offences under section 4BA of that Act, and to prescribe the demerit points to be imposed against the licence of the offender.

This Regulation is made under the *Traffic Act 1909*, including section 3 (the general regulation-making power) and section 18B.
