## **Dormant Funds Amendment (Reduction of Fees) Regulation 1997**

under the  
Dormant Funds Act 1942

### **Explanatory note**

At present, clause 7 of the *Dormant Funds Regulation 1994* provides that a fee is payable to the Commissioner of Dormant Funds with respect to any proposal for a dormant fund that is formulated by the Commissioner under section 11 of the *Dormant Funds Act 1942* (the Act).

The object of this Regulation is to amend that clause so as to allow the Minister administering the Act to reduce or waive the fee in any particular case in which the Minister considers it just and reasonable to do so.

This Regulation is made under the *Dormant Funds Act 1942*, and, in particular, under section 19 (the general regulation-making power).
