Travel Agents Amendment (Fees) Regulation 1997

under the
Travel Agents Act 1986

His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following Regulation under the *Travel Agents Act 1986*.

Explanatory note

The objects of this Regulation are:

- (a) to increase the application fee for a travel agent's licence from \$50 to \$60, and
- (b) to increase the licence fee for each place in which the business of a travel agent is carried on from \$235 to \$290, and
- (c) to remove three fees relating to the registration of the address of a business.

This Regulation is made under the *Travel Agents Act 1986*, including sections 8 (3), 10 (7), 17(1) and 57 (the general regulation-making power).

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Travel Agents Amendment (Fees) Regulation 1997*.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on 1 July 1997.

3 Amendment of Travel Agents Regulation 1995

The *Travel Agents Regulation 1995* is amended as set out in Schedule 1.

Omit “\$235” from clause 7 (1). Insert instead “\$290”.

Omit clause 11.
