## Explanatory note

The object of this Order is to amend the *Transport Administration (State Transit Authority—Fares) Order 1991*:

- (a) to increase certain fares for bus and ferry services in the Sydney Suburban Area (including services that are provided in conjunction with the rail services provided by the State Rail Authority), and
- (b) to provide for concessional travel on the special (racecourse) service to Royal Randwick racecourse.

This Order is made under the *Transport Administration Act 1988*, including section 85 (Orders fixing charges) and, in particular, section 85 (2).
