Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to prescribe Housing Loans Insurance Corporation Limited (formerly Housing Loans Insurance Corporation) as an approved insurer for the purposes of insuring repayment of loans secured by property.

This Regulation is made under the *Trustee Act 1925*, including section 18 (3) and section 104A (the general regulation making power).
