**ANTI-DISCRIMINATION AMENDMENT ACT 1997 No 9—
PROCLAMATION**

(L.S.) GORDON SAMUELS, Governor.

I, the Honourable Gordon Samuels AC, Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 2 of the *Anti-Discrimination Amendment Act 1997*, do, by this my Proclamation:

- (a) appoint 4 July 1997 as the day on which the whole Act (except Schedule 1 [10], to the extent that it inserts section 22E in the *Anti-Discrimination Act 1977*) commences, and
- (b) appoint 4 September 1997 as the day on which Schedule 1 [10], to the extent that it inserts section 22E in the *Anti-Discrimination Act 1977*, commences.
