**CINEMATOGRAPH FILMS (FURTHER SUSPENSION) ACT  
1985 No 31—PROCLAMATION**

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

The object of this Proclamation is to repeal certain unrepealed Acts and parts of Acts specified in Schedule 1 to the *Cinematograph Film (Further Suspension) Act 1985*. The unrepealed Acts and parts of Acts are as follows:

- the *Cinematograph Films Act 1935*
- so much of Schedule 8 to the *Miscellaneous Acts (Companies) Amendment Act 1981* as amends the *Cinematograph Films Act 1935*
