**DISTRICT COURT AMENDMENT ACT 1997—
PROCLAMATION**

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Proclamation commences the *District Court Amendment Act 1997*, except for the provisions of that Act:

- (a) that confer jurisdiction on the District Court to deal with matters under the *De Facto Relationships Act 1984*, and
- (b) that increase the Court's jurisdiction in relation to matters under the *Family Provision Act 1982* and the *Testator's Family Maintenance and Guardianship of infants Act 1916*, and
- (c) that make consequential amendments.
