Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to repeal amendments made to the *Electricity Supply (General) Regulation 1996* by the *Electricity Supply (General) Amendment (Victorian Power Exchange) Regulation 1997*. Those amendments will become unnecessary when the *Electricity Legislation Amendment (Wholesale Electricity Market) Act 1997* commences.

This Regulation is made in connection with the commencement of the *Electricity Legislation Amendment (Wholesale Electricity Market) Act 1997*.
