## **Explanatory note**

The object of this Regulation is to increase from \$70 to \$73 the fee payable under the Traffic Act 1909 where an application for the transfer of the registration of a motor vehicle is made more than 14 days after purchasing or acquiring possession of the motor vehicle.

This Regulation is made under the *Traffic Act 1909*, including section 3 (the general regulation-making power) and, in particular, section (3) (1) (m) (iii).
