**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

The object of this proclamation is to commence the provisions of the *Courts Legislation Amendment Act 1997* other than the provisions amending the *Land and Environment Court Act 1979* (amendments concerned with the determination of certain costs) and those amending the provisions of the *District Court Act 1973* and the *Supreme Court Act 1970* that deal with leave to appeal against certain judgments and orders of those Courts.
