**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

The object of this Proclamation is to make the Olympic Roads and Transport Authority subject to the obligations relating to the keeping of accounts and the inspection and audit of those accounts under Division 4A of Part 3 of the *Public Finance and Audit Act 1983*. As a consequence of being added to the list of Departments in Schedule 3 to that Act, the Olympic Roads and Transport Authority will also be subject to the reporting requirements under the Annual Reports (Department) Act 1985.
