Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to require statutory bodies to include information about their ethnic affairs priorities statements and information relating to the implementation of any ethnic affairs agreements negotiated with the Ethnic Affairs Commission in their annual reports under the *Annual Reports (Statutory Bodies) Act 1984*. The requirement for this information results from amendments made by the *Ethnic Affairs Commission Amendment Act 1996*, including amendments that recognise the principles of cultural diversity, require the Ethnic Affairs Commission to assess the effectiveness of public authorities in implementing the Government's ethnic affairs policies and confer other functions on the Commission relating to ethnic affairs agreements.

This Regulation is made under the *Annual Reports (Statutory Bodies) Act 1984*, including section 9 and section 17 (the general regulation making power).
