EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Proclamation is to commence the provisions of the *Statute Law (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1997* that amend section 56 (Penalty units) of the *Interpretation Act 1987*. Section 56 as amended will provide that one penalty unit is equivalent to \$110. The amendment will not affect the penalty for an offence committed before the commencement of the amendment.
