Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to prescribe the *Royal Botanic Gardens and Domain Trust* as an impounding authority for the purposes of the *Impounding Act 1993*, so enabling it to exercise the same powers with respect to abandoned property as are exercisable by other impounding authorities.

This Regulation is made in connection with the making of the *Royal Botanic Gardens and Domain Trust Regulation 1997*.

This Regulation is made under the *Impounding Act 1993*, including section 51 (the general regulation making power) and the Dictionary to that Act.
