## **Explanatory note**

The object of this Regulation is to transfer employees who transfer from Great Southern Energy to the Goldenfields Water County Council as a result of the creation of that County Council from their existing public sector superannuation schemes to the local government superannuation scheme.

This Regulation is made under the *Superannuation Administration Act 1996*, including section 128 and section 129 (the general regulation making power).

## **1 Name of Regulation**

This Regulation is the *Superannuation Administration (Local Government Superannuation Scheme Transitional Provisions) Further Amendment Regulation 1997*.

(Clause 3)

### **Clause 11 Employees of new county councils**

Insert at the end of clause 11 (2) (c):

- (d) employees of Great Southern Energy who transfer to the Goldenfields Water County Council and who, if Great Southern Energy were treated as a transferred employer as at the date of transfer, would be persons described in clause 6, 7, 8, 9 or 10 in respect of a superannuation scheme referred to in any of those clauses.
