Explanatory note

The Fair Trading Legislation Amendment Act 1997 abolished the Property Services Council and provided for the Director-General of the Department of Fair Trading to exercise the functions under the *Conveyancers Licensing Act 1995* formerly exercised by the Council.

The object of this Regulation is to update references to the Council in the *Conveyancers Licensing Regulation 1993*.

This Regulation is made under the *Conveyancers Licensing Act 1995*, including section 91 (the general regulation-making power).
