Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend Schedule 1 to the *Occupational Health and Safety (Penalty Notices) Regulation 1996* to update a reference to section 18 (Designers, manufacturers and suppliers to ensure health and safety as regards plant and substances for use at work) of the *Occupational Health and Safety Act 1983* as amended by the *Occupational Health and Safety Amendment Act 1997*. That Schedule lists, for the purposes of section 51B of the Act, provisions that create offences that may be dealt with by penalty notice.

This Regulation is made under the *Occupational Health and Safety Act 1983*, including sections 45 (the general regulation-making power) and 51B.

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Occupational Health and Safety (Penalty Notices) Amendment Regulation 1997*.
