Explanatory note

The *Fair Trading Legislation Amendment Act 1997* abolished the Property Services Council and provided for the Director-General of the Department of Fair Trading to exercise the functions under the *Valuers Registration Act 1975* formerly exercised by the Council or by its General Manager.

The object of this Regulation is to update references to the Property Services Council, and to the General Manager of the Council, in the *Valuers Registration Regulation 1993*.

This Regulation is made under the *Valuers Registration Act 1975*, including section 30 (the general regulation-making power).

[3] Clause 10 Surrender of certificate of registration

Omit “General Manager” wherever occurring in clause 10 (1).
Insert instead “Director-General”.
