**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

The object of this Proclamation is to commence provisions of the *Statute Law (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1997* that amend the *Bookmakers (Taxation) Act 1917*. The amendments relate to the time in which the tax imposed on bookmakers must be paid and the records relating to the tax must be forwarded to the Minister.
