EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Proclamation is to appoint a sale date for the purposes of Part 2 of the *Sydney Market Authority (Dissolution) Act 1997*. The sale date so appointed will be the earliest date from which any sale of the business undertaking of the Sydney Market Authority can take effect (see section 5 (5)), the earliest date from which any lease of the Flemington site of the Sydney Market Authority can be granted (see section 10 (1)) and the date immediately after which the Sydney Market Authority is to be dissolved (see section 13 (1)).
