DAMS SAFETY ACT 1978—PROCLAMATION

Gordon Samuels, Governor.

I, the Honourable Gordon Samuels AC, Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 27 (1) of the *Dams Safety Act 1978*, do, by this my Proclamation, amend Schedule 1 (Prescribed dams) to that Act:

- (a) by inserting in Columns 1 and 2 of that Schedule, in alphabetical order of the names of dams:

Green Meadows Retarding Basin	Green Meadows Estate, Albion Park Rail
Maddens Plains Holding Dam	Stony Creek, Maddens Plains near Coalcliff
Minmi Road Retarding Basin	Minmi Road, Fletcher, Newcastle
St Josephs School Retarding Basin	St Josephs School, Albion Park
Waverley Reservoir—WS 133	Waverley, Sydney

- (b) by omitting from Columns 1 and 2 of that Schedule:

Broombee	Saumarez Creek near Armidale
Castle Hill Agriculture Station	Castle Hill, Sydney
Liddell Ash Dam Levee	Near Muswellbrook
Rouse Hill Infrastructure Retarding Basin No 4	Caddies Creek at Glenmore
Stanwell	Stanwell Creek near Stanwell Park
Williams	Tributary of Mihi Creek near Walcha

Dams Safety Act 1978—Proclamation

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Proclamation is to add to Schedule 1 to the *Dams Safety Act 1978* certain dams that the Dams Safety Committee considers may present a safety hazard to life, property or the environment, and to omit from that Schedule those dams that the Committee considers no longer present such a hazard.

The *Dams Safety Act 1978* enables the Committee to exercise certain powers in relation to dams listed in that Schedule (eg the issuing of notices requiring work to be done in relation to the safety of a dam).
