Chapter X—Courses and Degrees

Omit By-law X.3 (2). Insert instead:

- (2) The Council may admit any person approved by the Council, *Honoris Causa*, to the following:
 - (a) the degree of Doctor of Science (HonDSc),
 - (b) the degree of Doctor of Letters (HonDLitt),
 - (c) the degree of Doctor of Laws (Hon LLD),
 - (d) the degree of Doctor of the University (HonDUniv).
