**CO-OPERATIVES AMENDMENT ACT 1997 No 39—  
PROCLAMATION**

G. SAMUELS, Governor.

I, the Honourable Gordon Samuels AC, Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 2 of the *Co-operatives Amendment Act 1997*, do, by this my Proclamation, appoint 1 December 1997 as the day on which that Act commences, except the following provisions:

- (a) Schedule 1 [9],
- (b) so much of Schedule 1 [12] as inserts sections 7 (2) and (3), 8 and 24 (c) (v),
- (c) Schedule 1 [17],
- (d) so much of Schedule 1 [45] as inserts section 109,
- (e) Schedule 1 [68],
- (f) Schedule 1 [93],
- (g) Schedule 1 [[109]–[111],
- (h) Schedule 1 [144],
- (i) Schedule 1 [212],
- (j) Schedule 1 [218].
