Explanatory note

Section 13 (2) of the *Prisoners (Interstate Transfer) Act 1982* provides for a certificate signed by a prescribed officer to be proof (in the absence of evidence to the contrary) that the consents or requests required to be given for the transfer of a prisoner to a participating State or Territory have been given or made.

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Prisoners (Interstate Transfer) Regulation 1994* to prescribe the Director, Community Relations Division, Attorney General's Department as an additional prescribed officer for the purposes of section 13 (2).

This Regulation is made under the *Prisoners (Interstate Transfer) Act 1982*, including section 13 (2).
