# TECHNICAL EDUCATION TRUST FUNDS ACT 1967—ORDER

Gordon Samuels, Governor.

I, the Honourable Gordon Samuels AC, Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 6 of the *Technical Education Trust Funds Act 1967*, do, by this my Order, with effect on and from 1 January 1998:

- (a) designate the Bishop Brothers Memorial Fund as a Fund for the purposes of that Act, and
- (b) specify, in relation to the Fund, the office of the Managing Director of the TAFE Commission as the office referred to in section 3 of that Act, and
- (c) specify, in relation to the Fund, “Trustee of the Bishop Brothers Memorial Fund” as the designation of the Statutory Trustee of the Fund, and
- (d) amend the Schedule to that Act by inserting at the end of the Schedule in the First and Second Column, respectively, the following matter:

Bishop Brothers Memorial Fund  
(constituted in terms of Deed dated  
13 May 1926, to provide for the  
annual award of a prize to a student,  
under 21 years of age attending a  
technical school and employed in the  
coachmaking section of the road  
vehicle trades (including motor  
body-building), for proficiency in  
trade linear drawing and projection).

On trust to apply the income for the  
purpose of awarding a prize, to be  
known as the “Bishop Brothers  
Memorial Prize”, as prescribed.
