**HEALTH LEGISLATION AMENDMENT ACT 1997 No 87—
PROCLAMATION**

G SAMUELS, Governor.

I, the Honourable Gordon Samuels AC, Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 2 of the *Health Legislation Amendment Act 1997*, do, by this my Proclamation, appoint:

- (a) 12 December 1997 as the day on which that Act (except Schedule 3) commences, and
- (b) 1 April 1998 as the day on which Schedule 3 to that Act commences.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Proclamation is to commence the whole of the *Health Legislation Amendment Act 1997*.

As a result of this Proclamation, amendments to the *Dental Technicians Registration Act 1975*, the *Drug Misuse and Trafficking Act 1985*, the *Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Act 1966*, and the *Private Hospitals and Day Procedure Centres Act 1988* commence on 12 December 1997, and amendments to the *New South Wales Institute of Psychiatry Act 1964* commence on 1 April 1998.
