**LIQUOR AND REGISTERED CLUBS LEGISLATION
FURTHER AMENDMENT ACT 1996 No 103—
PROCLAMATION**

(L.S.) GORDON SAMUELS, Governor.

I, the Honourable Gordon Samuels, AC, Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 2 (1) of the *Liquor and Registered Clubs Legislation Further Amendment Act 1996*, do, by this my Proclamation:

- (a) appoint 1 March 1997 as the day on which that Act (except for Schedules 1 and 2 [2]–[4], [9] and [10]) commences,
- (b) appoint 1 April 1997 as the day on which Schedules 1 (except for Schedule 1 [17] and [19], and so much of Schedule 1 [10] as would insert section 156 (1A) (v) and (w) in the Liquor Act 1982) and 2 [9] to that Act commence.
