RAIL SAFETY ACT 1993 No 50—PROCLAMATION

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this proclamation is to commence an uncommenced section of the *Rail Safety Act 1993* that provides that the owner or operator of a railway who employs, or enters into a contract with, a person to perform railway safety work is guilty of an offence unless the person holds an appropriate certificate of competency under that Act. **Railway safety work** includes work carried out by a railway employee as a train driver, guard or engineman as a station-master, operator of train signals or shunter of trains or connected with the repair, maintenance or upgrading of railway tracks or rolling stock.

This proclamation is made under section 2 of the Act.
