Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to provide for the adoption in New South Wales of a revised version of the Building Code of Australia.

This Regulation is made under the *Local Government Act 1993*, including section 748 (the general regulation making power) and clause 2 of Schedule 7 (which deals with savings, transitional and other provisions consequent on the enactment of that Act).

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Local Government (Savings and Transitional) Amendment (Building Code) Regulation 1998*.

2 Amendment of Local Government (Savings and Transitional) Regulation 1993

The *Local Government (Savings and Transitional) Regulation 1993* is amended as set out in Schedule 1.
