Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to bring the *Police Service Regulation 1990* into line with ranks and grades as they currently exist in the Police Service by providing for the rank of superintendent, and the grades of chief superintendent and superintendent within that rank.

This Regulation is made under the *Police Service Act 1990*, including section 12 (3) (ranks and grades of police officers and section 219 (the general regulation-making power).
