EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Proclamation commences so much of the *Sentencing Legislation Amendment Act 1997*:

- (a) as amends the *Children (Community Service Orders) Act 1987*, the *Periodic Detention of Prisoners Act 1981* and the *Home Detention Act 1996*, and
- (b) as amends the *Community Service Orders Act 1979* with respect to work that may be performed under a community service order and with respect to civil liability arising out of work incidents.
