Explanatory note

This Regulation increases from \$290 to \$295 the maximum amount of the minimum ordinary rate that a council may, without special Ministerial approval, make under section 548 of the *Local Government Act 1993*.

This Regulation is made under sections 548 (3) and 748 (the general regulation-making power) of that Act.

1 Name of Regulation
