## **Explanatory note**

Under the *Prohibited Weapons Act 1989*, a person must not possess or use a prohibited weapon unless authorised to do so by a permit. The object of this Regulation is to add imitations or replicas of firearms to the list of prohibited weapons in the Act.

This Regulation is made under the *Prohibited Weapons Act 1989*, including section 3 (4).

### Schedule 1 Prohibited weapons

Insert after item (27):

- (27A) Any imitation or replica of a firearm (including any imitation or replica pistol, blank fire pistol, shortened firearm, machine gun or sub-machinegun) unless it is of a type approved by the Commissioner of Police.
