**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

The object of this Proclamation is to commence a provision of the *Electricity Supply Act 1995* (section 31) that ensures that an electricity consumer may choose who is to provide any electrical or other goods or services that are required under the terms of a customer connection contract, subject to the provider of certain of those services being duly accredited to provide those services.
