Explanatory note

The objects of this Regulation are:

- (a) to provide that an offence under section 67A (4) of the Act, namely, failing to leave club premises after a request by a club secretary, employee or police officer, may be dealt with by way of a penalty notice, and
- (b) to specify a short description for that offence to facilitate the issue of penalty notices and other legal processes.

This Regulation is made under the *Registered Clubs Act 1976*, including sections 66 and 73 (the general regulation-making power) and in accordance with section 145B of the *Justices Act 1902*.
