Explanatory note

The object of this Order is to amend the *Transport Administration (State Transit Authority—Fares) Order 1991*:

- (a) to change the name of the ticket described as "Sydney DayTripper" to "Sydney DayPass", and
- (h) to increase certain fares for bus and ferry services in the Sydney Suburban Area and the Newcastle Suburban Area.

1 Name of Order

This Order is the *Transport Administration (State Transit Authority—Fares) Amendment (No 2) Order 1998*.

2 Commencement

This Order commences on 5 July 1998.

3 Amendment of Transport Administration (State Transit Authority—Fares) Order 1991

The *Transport Administration (State Transit Authority—Fares) Order 1991* is amended as set out in Schedule 1.

The explanatory note does not form part of this Order.

[2] Clause 9 Certain services excluded from TravelPasses etc

Omit “Sydney DayTripper”. Insert instead “Sydney DayPass”.

[3] Clause 13 Definitions

Omit the definition of *Sydney DayTripper ticket* from clause 13 (1).
Insert instead:

Sydney DayPass ticket means a ticket that allows unlimited travel on the State Transit Authority’s bus services and ferry services.
