Explanatory note

The *Darling Harbour (Monorail) Regulation 1994* provides that a person must not, except in certain circumstances, enter the monorail envelope or cause or permit anything to enter the monorail envelope. The monorail envelope is currently defined as the space around the monorail measured from the centreline of the monorail beam. The object of this Regulation is to amend the definition so that the space around the monorail is measured from the centre of the bottom surface of the monorail beam.

This Regulation is made under the *Darling Harbour Authority Act 1984*, including section 67 (the general regulation-making power).
