EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Proclamation commences the *Workers Compensation Legislation Amendment Act 1998* with the exception of Schedule 1 [19], [66] and [67], which make amendments to the *Workers Compensation Act 1987* that are consequential on (uncommenced) provisions of the *Workplace Injury Management and Workers Compensation Act 1998* relating to injury management.
