## **Motor Traffic Amendment (Log Book) Regulation 1998**

under the  
Traffic Act 1909

His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following Regulation under the *Traffic Act 1909*.

### **Explanatory note**

The object of this Regulation is to enable the Roads and Traffic Authority to issue a new type of log book for use by drivers of heavy motor vehicles and coaches. The new log book is called a National Driver's Log Book. It replaces the Professional Driver's Log Book and the Special Purpose Driver's Log Book that are currently in use. However, drivers will be able to continue to use those log books until 5 April 1999.

The Regulation also amends the Schedule of fees under the *Motor Traffic Regulations 1935* for the purpose of prescribing a fee for the issue of a National Driver's Log Book and for the purpose of law revision.

This Regulation is made under section 3 of the *Traffic Act 1909*, in particular section 3 (1) (t1) .

### **1 Name of Regulation**

This Regulation is the *Motor Traffic Amendment (Log Book) Regulation 1998*.
