EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Proclamation is to commence the uncommenced provisions of the *State Revenue Legislation Further Amendment Act 1998*. Those provisions include the following

- (a) Schedule 1 [9] which amends the *Duties Act 1997* in respect of the rate of duty chargeable for certain motor vehicles.
- (b) Schedule 2 which contains amendments to the *Land Tax Act 1956*.
- (c) Schedule 3 which contains amendments to the *Land Tax Management Act 1956*.
