EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Proclamation is to make the State Valuation Office subject to the obligations relating to the keeping of accounts and the inspection and audit of those accounts under Division 3 of Part 3 of the *Public Finance and Audit Act 1983*. As a consequence of being added to the list of statutory bodies in Schedule 2 to that Act, the State Valuation Office will also be subject to the reporting requirements under the *Annual Reports (Statutory Bodies) Act 1984*.
