Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to remove the reference to the Department of Land and Water Conservation from the list of Departments to which Division 4A of Part 3 of the *Public Finance and Audit Act 1983* applies. That Division relates to the keeping of accounts by Departments and the inspection and audit of those accounts.

A reference to the Department (not including the State Valuation Office) is to be added to the list by proclamation under section 45B (1) of the *Public Finance and Audit Act 1983*.

This Regulation is made under section 45B (3) of the *Public Finance and Audit Act 1983*.
