COMPANION ANIMALS ACT 1998 No 87—PROCLAMATION

(L.S.) JAMES JACOB SPIGELMAN, Lieutenant-Governor.

I, the Honourable James Jacob Spigelman, Lieutenant-Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 2 of the *Companion Animals Act 1998*, do, by this my Proclamation, appoint 1 September 1998 as the day on which that Act commences, except for the following provisions:

- (a) Parts 2 and 8,
- (b) sections 29, 30 (3) and (4), 32, 64 (4) and 84 (1) (a),
- (c) section 99 (1) to the extent that it would repeal Parts 1 and 5, and sections 5 and 21-27, of the *Dog Act 1966*,
- (d) section 99 (1) to the extent that it would repeal the *Dog Regulation 1997*,
- (e) Part 2 of Schedule 3.
- (f) Schedule 4.1 [1].
