Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to exempt any veteran to whom section 24 of the *Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986* of the Commonwealth applies from the requirement to pay a fee for transferring a vehicle's registration into the veteran's name. Section 24 of that Act deals with special rates of pension for certain incapacitated veterans.

This Regulation is made under the *Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Act 1997*, including section 14 (the general-regulation making power).

Clause 36 Obligations of acquirers

Insert after clause 36 (4):

- (5) A person who acquires, or the agent of a person who acquires, a registered registrable vehicle is not required to pay the applicable scheduled fee referred to in subclause (1) if the person is a veteran to whom section 24 of the *Veterans' Entitlements Act 1986* of the Commonwealth applies.
