**SUPERANNUATION LEGISLATION AMENDMENT ACT 1998**  
**No 72—PROCLAMATION**

(L.S.)      **GORDON SAMUELS**, Governor.

I, the Honourable Gordon Samuels AC, Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 2 (1) of the *Superannuation Legislation Amendment Act 1998*, do, by this my Proclamation, appoint:

- (a) 1 October 1998 as the day on which sections 1-4 of that Act, and Schedule 1.2, Schedule 1.4 [6] and [14] and Schedule 1.4 [15] (insofar as it inserts the heading to Part 6 of Schedule 25 and clauses 11 and 16 (1) to Schedule 25) to that Act, commence, and
- (b) 1 December 1998 as the day on which Schedule 1.4 [7]–[9] and Schedule 1.4 [15] (insofar as it inserts clause 16 (2) to Schedule 25) to that Act commence, and
- (c) 1 January 1999 as the day on which the remaining uncommenced provisions of that Act commence.
