EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Proclamation is to commence the *Crimes Amendment (Detention after Arrest) Act 1997* (except Schedule 2). Schedule 2 is not commenced because it amends an uncommenced provision of the *Children (Criminal Proceedings) Act 1987*.
