**ADMINISTRATIVE DECISIONS TRIBUNAL ACT 1997 No 76—

- (b) Part 1 of Schedule 2.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

The object of this proclamation is to commence all the provisions of the *Administrative Decisions Tribunal Act 1997* (other than those relating to the establishment and composition of the Community Services Division of the Tribunal),

in particular, the proclamation commences Part 2 of Schedule 5 to the Act which (in combination with the proposed commencement of Schedules 2, 3 and 4 to the *Administrative Decisions Legislation Amendment Act 1997* on the same day) will abolish the following tribunals and transfer their functions to the Administrative Decisions Tribunal:

- Boxing Appeals Tribunal.
- Equal Opportunity Tribunal.
- Legal Services Tribunal.
- Schools Appeals Tribunal.
- Veterinary Surgeons Disciplinary Tribunal.
