EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this proclamation is to commence certain provisions of the *Administrative Decisions Tribunal Legislation Amendment Act 1998* that:

- (a) amend the *Administrative Decisions Tribunal Act 1997* in respect of the constitution of the Tribunal and qualifications for membership and savings and transitional matters (Schedule 1 [1]-[3] and [6]-[8]), and
- (b) amend the *Veterinary Surgeons Act 1986* to confer jurisdiction on the Tribunal to review certain decisions made under that Act (Schedule 2.25).
